George Wells celebrated his 55th year in songwriting in June of 2017.

Back in 1962, he was doing a lot of flying and spending time in airports. He decided to try his hand at lyrics to pass the time. Meeting many songwriters on his travels along the way, he'd get a lot of ideas for the songs he would write. He wrote as often as he could and estimates that over the years, he's written 5,000 lyrics.

George's longtime co-writer, Billy Stone, and he spent several years knocking on the doors in Nashville. Together, they placed a total of about 25 songs with a number of publishers. One such publisher placed their song, *Turn the Record Over*, in a full-length movie, "From Nashville with Music".

George's real joy comes from the people he has met. He worked with Gene Stallings, Charlie Walker, Neil Bonnett, Jim Hamill, and Orval Profit. He and Billy have also worked hard in the studio with many legends in the music business. This year, they have released three songs and two videos.

As George puts it, "So the love for the skill of writing lives on."
